After reading John chapter 13, ask yourself this question: Would you rather have an entire restaurant reserved for you and your friends to eat dinner at together or would you rather just run out and grab something quick to eat on your own? Share why you chose your answer:

Read John 13:1-2 If you could choose up to twelve people to have dinner with, who would you choose and why?

Now read the notes for John 13:1 and John 13:2. What if one of the people you invited was going to turn his or her back on you and you knew it was going to happen. How would you deal with this person?

Read John 13:3-8 and the study note on these verses. This is the beginning of what theologians have titled "The Last Supper". According to these verses, how did communion begin?

If you go to church, or used to go to church, how often do/did you celebrate communion? Every week? Or, do/did they just celebrate on special occasions? Why do you feel your church did this?

Read John 13:12-20 and the study note on John 13:12-17. According to the note, why did Jesus sit down?

According to what Jesus shares with the disciples, how did Jesus lead them according to John 13:15?

What did Jesus challenge his disciples to do with His teachings, according to John 13:17?

What example did the writer of the gospel, John, the one Jesus loved, do back to Jesus, according to John 13:23 and the note for this verse. What are some ways that you have or can do to live the same example as John did?

According to John 13:26, how did Jesus deal with Judas, knowing he would be the one to betray him? Read the note on John 13:26. How do we know for sure that the writer in John and the writer in the other gospels were correct in what they wrote about who betrayed Jesus?
